Online Training event: Setting up a multibed clinic - 2nd March 2020

We're delighted to be running another online workshop with Charlie Whitestone on 'how to set up a multibed clinic'.

Charlie is the founder and Director of ACMAC and has worked in various

multibeds for over a decade and is passionate about seeing affordable acupuncture spread throughout all our communities.

Running a multibed clinic may be something that you've been thinking about but just don't know where to start. Or you may be keen but feeling nervous about the economic climate and don't know how to make it succeed. A multibed clinic can be a sustainable and profitable business model if you get the right things in place and attending one of our training events will help you to get there.

This online course will give you the basic tools and information you need to start up your own multibed clinic. We will cover issues such as: what's best - working in a team or working alone, finding a good venue, marketing your clinic, how to structure your clinic sessions, ethics of multibed practice and the importance of informed consent, and much more.

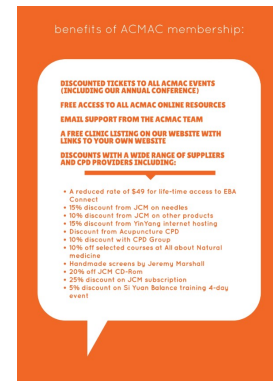
